It is observed that the children speaking English as a mother tongue (L1) have the developmental order for wh-questions. Also the children studying English as L2 showed the similar developmental order for English wh-questions. The purpose of this study is to examine the developmental order for wh-questions in Korean learners and the distribution for wh-questions of English textbooks in middle school. The subjects consisted of 115 middle school students. They were tested by 36 wh-questions composed of 18 subjective questions and 18 objective questions. The results of this study showed that Korean students had the same developmental order (where, what, who, how, why, when) for English wh-questions as L2. The results also indicated that for the frequency distribution of wh-questions, English text books for middle school students in Korea did not reflect the developmental order for English wh-questions.
